By clicking your account type below, you will be taken to the necessary instructions to complete the application based on your account type.

Purpose of this form - *By completing and signing this application the account owner is establishing an account subject to the terms and conditions made available by your advisor and outlined at trustamerica.com/tca. This form is required to open a managed account through your designated investment advisor, with TCA by E*TRADE providing custodial services to you and your investment advisor.*

Where to get additional forms - *If additional TCA by E*TRADE forms are needed, you may either ask your investment advisor or client representative for a copy of the form or download the form online at trustamerica.com/advisor-forms.*

You must **complete all required fields and provide all required additional forms and documentation** to expedite processing and to avoid requests for additional information. The only exceptions are if a section or entry is listed as 'optional' or 'if applicable'. 'Optional' indicates the section or entry is an elective and nonobligatory service or feature. By entering information in an optional section or entry, you are choosing to participate in the service or feature. 'If applicable' indicates the section or entry is required if certain conditions apply. These conditions are outlined in detail in these instructions.

Print or type all entries. Print clearly in all CAPITAL LETTERS to complete this application. To type entries, a fillable PDF of this form can be found online at trustamerica.com/advisor-forms.

Unknown information - If information is requested and you do not know where to obtain the requested information, contact your investment advisor or client representative for direction.

Important New Account Information To help the government fight the funding of terrorism and money-laundering activities, federal law requires TCA by E*TRADE to verify your identity by obtaining your name, date of birth, address, and a government-issued identification number before opening your account. Solo(k)/Solo(k) Roth

Solo(k)

Check the account type Solo(k) if you would like to make or have already made regular contributions to your account.

Solo(k) with ROTH

Check the account type Solo(k) with Roth if you would like to make or have already made ROTH contributions to your account. Both Solo(k) and Solo(k) Roth accounts will be setup to keep the contributions segregated.

If you are opening a new TCA by E*TRADE Plan, an Adoption Agreement for TCA by E*TRADE Solo 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan and Trust is required.

Please indicate if you are opening an additional Participant Account for an Existing TCA by E*TRADE Solo(k) Plan by completing section 4, E, ii.

i. Type of Business: Check the box indicating the Employer's type of business. If other, check the box marked 'Other' and enter the type of business below.

ii. Existing TCA by E*TRADE Plan #. If this account is being established under a plan that already exists at TCA by E*TRADE, please input the account number for that plan and do not complete an additional Adoption Agreement.

Section 5: Account Management

A. Client Representative

Enter the information for the client representative that is associated with or referring you to the Investment Advisor that will be managing the account.

B. Investment Advisor Information

Qualified retirement plan (with or without tax reporting)

Qualified Retirement Plan – with Form 1099-R reporting: TCA by E*TRADE provides Form 1099-R participant level reporting.

Qualified Retirement Plan – with NO Form 1099-R reporting: TCA by E*TRADE does not provide Form 1099-R reporting.

Pooled Account. This is a trustee-directed pooled account in which all assets are owned at the plan level.

Participant Account. This is an account for one participant (also known as For the Benefit Of (FBO) account). For individual FBO accounts, assets for each participant are held in separate accounts. If you choose this option, you must submit a separate application for each participant.

Important: To open a Solo 401(k) Plan account with TCA by E*TRADE Plan documents, complete the Solo 401(k) Plan Account Application and the Solo 401(k) Adoption Agreement. To open a 401(k), contact your representative or investment advisor for information regarding TCA by E*TRADE 401(k) services.
